1. Whether companies from Outside USA can apply for this? (like, from India or Canada)

The proposer should operate in the United States. The proposer's specific location or headquarters will not solely impact the award. However, the proposer is expected to comply with all requirements outlined in E. Technical Qualifications of the Request for Proposals (RFP) that includes but is not limited to, "If a corporation, limited liability company, or limited partnership, certification that it is registered with the Secretary of State of the State of California and in good standing." In addition, strongest responders will have demonstrated past experience serving workforce board clients.

2. Whether we need to come over there for meetings?

In-person meetings will be determined at contract negotiations.

3. Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA? (like, from India or Canada)

As stated in the RFP, the proposer should include a scope of services that meets the diverse needs of residents and employers operating in the NOVAworks region. The region encompasses the Silicon Valley cities of Cupertino, Los Altos, Milpitas, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Santa Clara and Sunnyvale, and the County of San Mateo in California.
