

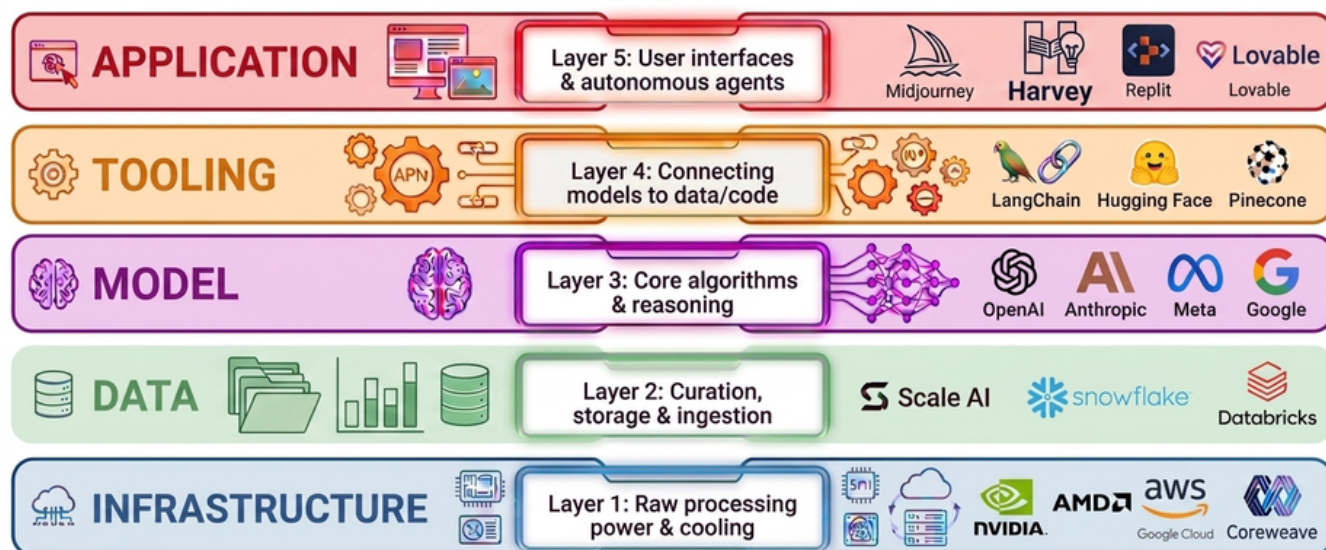

Understand Your Profession's AI Landscape: What AI tools and large language models (LLMs) are being used in your field? What guardrails matter, and how can you verify that those guardrails actually exist?

- ♦ **Practice Co-Development:** Can you provide the AI with exact, context-rich prompts? If AI misses the mark, can you fix mistakes, debug errors, and verify its "facts," or steer the AI with a better prompt?
- ♦ **Define Your Unique Value:** Have absolute clarity around the specific skills and experiences you "bring to the party." Ask yourself: What makes me valuable and needed as a human? What are my unique skills?
- ♦ **Demonstrate Experimentation with AI:** Have you taken a past project and rethought it using AI so you have a concrete project to talk about? Determine if using the AI tools make the process more efficient or if it adds an entirely new dimension to the work. What current AI projects are you trying?
